Wayne Henderson's top-notch finger-picking is a continuing source of great pleasure and pride in Grayson County, VA; fortunately for the rest of the world, his guitar playing has also been heard at Carnegie Hall, in three national tours of "Masters of the Steel-String Guitar", and in seven nations in Asia.

Henderson is also a luthier of great renown, having received a 1995 National Heritage Award presented by the NEA. He produces about 20 instruments a year, mostly guitars and some mandolins. Henderson's new CD, *Made & Played*, features a guitar similar to the one featured in "Clapton's Guitar: Watching Wayne Henderson Build the Perfect Instrument" a book by Allen St. John that tells the story of how Henderson built a guitar for rock legend Eric Clapton, after keeping him waiting for more than 10 years. To make a great guitar – it is integral to know how to play it. And that is precisely what Wayne Henderson does best.
